





The American Kennel Club established the AKC Outstanding Sportsmanship Award Program in 2006 to provide each member club with an AKC Medallion to award to one of its own members on a yearly basis.

This award is intended to honor an HPCA Member who deserves special recognition for having made a difference in the sport of purebred dogs, embodied the AKC Code of Sportsmanship, and been an active and valued member of our club in the year prior to the Pumifest at which it will be presented. An individual may only receive this award once.

Nominations must be from an HPCA member in good standing in the form of an essay stating why the individual is deserving of this award. The essay should describe the activities of this individual that makes them a worthy candidate and explain how this person is deserving of the award.

The deadline for receipt of the nomination is July 24, 2020.

After all nominations have been received, a ballot will be sent to the membership which will be used to declare a winner. The HPCA will announce the recipient of the AKC Outstanding Sportsmanship Award at the Annual Meeting at Pumifest.
