Preface

The Pumi Pedigree Database Online is one of the most powerful tools we have to improve the Pumi and keep it true to its original, loveable, smart, active, healthy form. This manual serves to assist you in using the database to its full potential, meaning that you will be not only reading, but adding to the information available here.

This database is meant for all Pumi owners all over the world. The Hungarian Pumi Club of America pays for the license for the software, but it is truly a worldwide effort. Each breeder should add their puppies as they're registered in their country. Then each owner should keep up the title and health information for their Puim(s).

A Bit about Data Privacy

This application is hosted in The Netherlands. The European Union of which they are a part, has a *General Data Protection Regulation* (GDPR). What it means for us is that no one's name can be listed as owner or breeder without their permission. A kennel name is OK – it's the personal information like name, address, phone, etc. that is protected by the GDPR.

If you want anyone using the system to be able to see that you are the owner and/or breeder of a dog, you must agree to have your information "public". On your account into, click the "I want a public page" checkbox. This allows you to add your name to the dog as breeder and/or owner and have it display for others' view. When a user sees your name (or kennel name) on the dog, they can click your name and it will bring up another screen with additional information about you (like country). If you would like people to be able to contact you, click the checkbox for "a contact form so people can send me an email" on your account information. Your email address is never displayed on this application to prevent unwanted bots from obtaining your email address.

Helpful Hints

1. Resident Country: When you're updating your dogs, the Country of Origin is assumed to be the Resident Country unless that dog has changed countries. If it has changed countries, the current valid Registration Number should be the one from the Resident Country and if known, the original registration number should go in the Other Registration Number field. For example, if a dog was imported from Hungary:

Reg. No.: DN12345678 Resident Country: United States
Other Registration No.: 1234/19 Country of Origin: Hungary


- 2. **Hungarian registration numbers** all begin with "MET.Pm." and for simplicity's sake, we are leaving off that portion. If the dog is Hungarian, the Reg. No. would just be the 4 numbers, slash, 2-digit year of birth (e.g. 1234/19). That is not true of other countries however. Most have a very short letter prefix to tell you in which country they are registered.
- 3. **Stud Dog List**: if you want to have your dog listed in the Stud Dog List, you need to 1) be listed as the owner of the dog, and 2) set the BreedDog field to "Active". This will automatically add your dog to the list of stud dogs. If you have frozen semen available for him, check the Frozen Semen Available checkbox.

- 4. **Breeder List**: On your account information, check the box for "Add my name to the breeders list." As you can see this is the same screen as for Owners, just with more information. Putting yourself on the Breeders List will add you to the list of breeders on the website. Please be sure to add a photo for your listing.
- 5. **Account Information:** When you chose to get a login, you filled out some fields and clicked "Submit". You can go back and change those fields as needed by clicking the person icon in the upper right-hand corner of the screen and choose "edit my account". Some of the information in this article will be associated with the fields and checkboxes on that screen.

How to Use This Document


Each chapter is defined by the choices you have at the top of the screen and the items that go with them:



When you see the main menu item duplicated in the indented item, it goes to the same item. For example, clicking the "search" item on the main menu is the same as hovering over that menu and selecting the first choice which is "search". This just saves a bit of time.

Home

This goes to the *Home_*screen.




From here you can log in or do any of the links listed above. The "Random results" are just a random selection of dogs, stud dogs, and kennels.

You may search for dogs and view their pedigree without signing up, but there are more functions available if the user creates a username/email and password.

Free Sign-Up

You may sign up for free.



The Administrator does not need to approve this.

Also on this screen (see below) is the ability to sign up as a breeder/owner. This allows the user to edit their own dogs and add others. It also allows the user to create their own *Breed Page*.



The user fills out the form and presses save. Then they will get an e-mail with a link to confirm their email address. Once it's confirmed by the user, the Administrator must approve it. This could take up to a day. When approved, you'll receive an email.



If you signed up to be on the Breeder List, please add a photo for your kennel. Go to your listing and click the icon next to your kennel name. This will bring up you account screen and you can add a photo in the lower left-hand corner of the screen.



Search

The search uses a "contains" function so it will find any part of a dog's name that contains what you keyed in. See the example in the screen below.



You can also search on RegNo, Color, and DOB and you can choose to sort by Name or DOB.

The search will be carried out as you key in the word(s).

You can also list all dogs in the database whose name begins with a letter – see the letters in the screen above.

From here you can click on the Advanced Search.

Search Issues

The search capability is very strong, using an "includes" function, but it's still easy to search and not find a dog for several reasons. There are many, many old dogs in the system, thanks to Tamara Langer's spreadsheet that she had compiled many years ago. If you're searching for an older dog (1960-2000), it might just be because the name you're searching on isn't quite the same as the name in the system for the following reasons.

Hyphen

If a name includes a hyphen, search without using the hyphen because the system will look for both without and with the hyphen. If you search using the hyphen, it will look for <u>only</u> the dog names that have the hyphen. For example, if you search for "Cseri Subas", it will find those names <u>with</u> and <u>without</u> a hyphen. If you search for "Cseri-Subas" it will look for all those only with a hyphen.

There are several kennel names that were imported into the database without hyphens and need to have them. I am asking PDO to change all of them at some point.

It's still best to search without using the hyphen.

Commas

Commas can be written differently (even though they may look the same) and will not find a dog if you include the comma. The best thing to try is type in the dog name up to the comma. For example, one kennel name is

"Jellum's". If you type in "Jellum" it will list all those dogs. If you type in "Jellum's" it may not find any of them depending on if you're using a PC or a mobile device. The PC seems to be more stable that way.

Kennel Name Order

There are some older dogs where it's not clear whether the kennel name comes before the specific name or after it. If you search for an older dog and can't find it, try reversing the names. For example, the system had both "Csutak Ragendorfi" and "Ragendorfi Csutak". They both had the same registration number so we could identify and correct it. But it might be better to just search on the kennel name only and see what it finds.

Call Names

Many times in Hungary, the dog's call name is added to the registered name. If there are multiple names, it's best to search on the kennel name plus only one other name, then compare registration numbers to make sure you have the right dog. For example, Sziki Mara and Sziki Mara Morgó were both in the database. The "Morgó" was moved to the call name and the other one deleted.


Advanced Search

The Advanced Search includes every single field of information on a dog. For example, if you wanted to find a dog whose color was KB/KB and HD A and lived in Hungary, you can do that. You must have a logon ID to use the Advanced Search.

Common Ancestors

On this page you can compare pedigrees and search for the first common ancestors to, for example, trace genetic defects.




Clicking one of the letters of the alphabet will provide a list of all the dogs whose registered name starts with that letter. In many cases there are so many names that it doesn't really make it worth trying to search for a dog using this method.

Please take note of the information at the bottom of the page:

You may only add health information for a dog you own or bred. Please be able to verify this information if asked. The Admin will only request verification if there is some question about the health clearance info.

You may:

- Save and the popup window will disappear after saving the dog
- Save and go to pedigree which will take you to the dog's page
- Cancel


Add a Litter

Click on add a dog on the dropdown menu (see below), and then click add a litter.



This will bring up a popup window:

You must find the parents first. If you find the dam and she has any existing litters or puppies in the database, it will list them at that time. If you choose an existing litter, any puppies from that litter will automatically be added to the list:



Key in the mother's name (the system will give you the choice) and the father. Put in the date of birth, then click *Continue*. The screen changes to:



The name of the owner of the dam is automatically added as the breeder of record.

The following is added to the bottom of the screen.



- Children with the same mother, father and DOB have been added automatically. You can add new animals or search for existing animals in the name field.
- All new and existing children in this list will get the mother, father, date of birth and breeder from the fields above.
- Removing animals from this list will not delete existing animals or remove them from this litter, but they will not be updated with possible changes.
- Entries in the grey line are applied to all animals on the list.
- Set the breeder as the owner of the children:

Please note the instructions above. We recently had a upgrade to the pedigree application, and some of these instructions are new.

- Children with the same mother, father and DOB have been added automatically. You can add new animals or search for existing animals in the name field.
- All new and existing children in this list will get the mother, father, date of birth and breeder from the fields above.
- Removing animals from this list will not delete existing animals or remove them from this litter, but they will not be updated with possible changes.

These all explain how the *adding a litter* function works. If there are already puppies from this litter in the database, they will be added automatically when this screen shows up. The ones already in the database and added automatically cannot be changed except that the breeder will be added automatically along with the other fields that you can update.

The next one talks about a great function of the this screen:

- Entries in the grey line are applied to all animals on the list.

So for example, if you put "United States" in the gray line above on the County of Origin field, that will populate that field for all of the puppies. Same applies to color, so you can easily mark all puppies as "black".

The default screen shows 3 puppies (in addition to any added automatically), but you can add more lines by clicking the + add animal button. All the Dog Info fields are available here except Breeder and Owner. (If there is an owner for the dam, the owner will automatically be listed as the breeder on all the puppies.)

As you type in a name, it will check to make sure the dog isn't already in the database. If there is another dog of that name in the database, it will list that name and you can choose it to become part of this litter.



Most of the fields available for individual dogs are available here by scrolling to the right, including all the health information, and color DNA information, microchip info, etc.

Clicking the **Submit** button will add each dog in the litter individually to the database! Done!

You can also update an existing litter using this screen. Go to the dog record for either sire or dam and click "Add litter". The existing litters will be listed and choose one. It will show the litter and you can update all the puppies at once.

This is an easy way to update the breeder of a litter if you didn't have one originally. Go to the dam's page and make sure there is an owner for the dam. Click the "Add litter" choice on the hamburger and choose the litter. It will show the puppies with 3 additional lines – delete them by clicking the "X" at the left. Then click "Save" and the litter will now have the breeder's name on all the puppies. (This does not work to remove a breeder's name.)

You can choose how many generation to use in the COI, from 5 - 10. None of this is editable.

Documents

The *Documents* hamburger allows you to add files. Click on the Documents link to get a popup window to add a file. One suggestion might be the Optimal Selection DNA test results document.

Pedigree

The default is a 5-generation pedigree with a lot of information on the closer ancestors. You can set what you want to see on this menu at the top of the pedigree:




You can go from 3 to generations. A vertical pedigree shows all siblings.

The default is that photos of dogs only show for the first 2 generations, but you can change it to from 0 (no photos at all) to 7 generations.

You can also choose which dog information to see in the filter information, none, all, or specific fields.

Because of the size of the pedigree, only part of it will be shown here.



Any duplicated dogs in the pedigree are highlighted with the same color. You can see that there are two pink ones – those are the same dog. The others you can't see here because this is only a partial capture of the screen.

You can see the entire pedigree here without photo or accompanying information.

Hamburger Choices



The "hamburger" is the 3 parallel horizontal lines (≡) after a dog's name. If you click on this it will give you options. The options are shown to the left and described below.

Edit

This brings up the Add a Dog screen and you can edit all the data there. See "Add a Dog".

Add Sibling

This brings up the *Add a Dog* screen but with the fields pre-filled with the original dog's into, so you must change the name, registration number(s) at a minimum. The sex is not filled out and is a mandatory field.

Add Child


This brings up the *Add a Dog* screen and all fields are blank except the sire or dam field (depending on the sex of the parent).

Add Litter

This brings up the Add a Litter screen with the sire or dam field (depending on the sex of the parent) pre-filled.

Log

This screen shows the changes to the dog's record, for example:



Trial Mating

This brings up the *Trial Mating* screen with the sire or dam field (depending on the sex of the parent) prefilled. You can also get to this screen from a link on the pedigree header. Or a blank screen from the top menu.

Delete (Admin only)

There is no reason to delete a dog unless it is a duplicate of another one in the system.


You <u>must</u> be sure that there are no direct descendants before deleting a dog. If there are, you can change the sire or dam to the correct record prior to deleting it. The Direct offspring/Litters heading must say "no data" before deleting! Only a user with Administrator privileges can delete a dog. If you need to delete one, contact Chris.

Remove as Parent

This is only an option on the pedigree portion of the screen. This will remove the dog as a parent on the pedigree in case of an error.

Trialmating

This allows you to see pedigree and pedigree analysis information for a potential breeding. You can fill in the parents or grandparents. The pedigree screen is identical to the screen for an actual dog so it's not displayed here.



There are some conventions that will help understand what the changes actually were:

Example 1:

In this case the user (Jennycobb) changed the PreTitle field from "GCHB" to "GCHS".
