Non-AKC certificates/titles can count towards this HPCA title.

The program is open to Hungarian Pumi Club of America members in good standing.

There are 4 levels of versatility awards:

- → VP1 (Versatile Pumi Level 1)
- → VP2 (Versatile Pumi Level 2)
- → VP3 (Versatile Pumi Level 3)
- → VP Gold (Versatile Pumi Gold)

## Aimee's Story

Hi,

My name is Ammie and I asked my family to help me tell my story.



I was rescued April 24<sup>th</sup> along with several other Pumik when my human caretaker became very ill and could no longer take care of us. I have a lame leg and none of the humans know how or when it happened, only that I was not born that way. We spent some time at the veterinary hospital before a very kind woman named Cameron took me and my sister home with her until my rescue team could locate my forever home. Another kind lady named Sandy came to give me a bath and a new hairdo.

A family in South Carolina contacted the rescue team and Linda spent many hours on the phone telling them about me. They fell in love with me the moment they saw my picture and wanted to adopt me. It was a long trip from Texas to South Carolina, but worth it. My new Pumi brother Kodi greeted me and we now have a new Pumi baby sister (they say she will grow on us). I am so happy to have a new family that loves me.

I want to tell you my story for some important reasons. First, I want to thank everyone who was involved in rescuing us including those who

generously donated money for the rescue and our care. I hope you know how grateful we are for everything you did for us. I have a new home thanks to the time and efforts of so many kind Pumi owners.

Finally, there's also a lesson here that hopefully will help other Pumik avoid or at least make an awful situation easier.

We can all agree that we are a special breed that may not be a good fit for everyone. This makes it especially important that there is a plan for our care if something awful happens to our owners, like what happened to mine. You may be lucky enough that your breeder or a family member whom you trust implicitly with your Pumi's life, is willing and able to care for your Pumi. You should also consider creating a trust to provide a legal agreement for the care of your Pumi. After all we are you children too, aren't we?

A pet trust is a legal arrangement. Pet trusts should designate a caretaker, provide financial assets from the estate to care for the pet and specify the type of care the pet should receive. The trust can specify many different detailed aspects of your Pumi's care, including: Veterinary records, special health issues (like my leg), food, living environment and favorite activities/training.

The funds that are provided for your Pumi's care should be carefully calculated to ensure that they will be adequate for the lifetime care of your Pumi. You can also specify your wishes for your Pumi's end-of-life care. You may find a great deal of comfort in knowing that your Pumi's needs will be met should your Pumi outlive you.

My story turned out to be a happy one, thanks to the efforts of so many generous Pumi owners, but I know you don't want your Pumi to go through what we did.

#### **Lola Meets the Twins**





My tongue tickled whenever one landed on it. I felt a ping when one made it past my eyelashes and hit my eyeball. I had white dots everywhere.


OMG! They were trying the eat me!

I just couldn't keep up.


Trying to fill my mouth with one grab. Holding my mouth open, running around while they tickled my tongue and lips. Racing through them, making a swirling, spinning design in the air.

## The Pumi is a Solid Color with Shadings

At this time I am aware of 2 occasions where a judge has disqualified a Pumi for being more than one color. In both cases the Pumi was not genetically two colors and probably should not have been disqualified. So let me explain.

All (correct) silver gray Pumik are genetically black, with either a "KB" gene (dominant black) or two "a" genes (recessive black). In other words, they are <u>not</u> genetically gray (d/d/d). All silver gray puppies are born black, with black noses and pigment.

The greying gene (G locus - still undiscovered via DNA), is progressive, so a dog with the greying gene is born solid black and becomes lighter as it gets older). The graying doesn't always affect the whole of the coat to the same extent (the shade of grey in different parts may vary, and some parts may even remain black). When a new hair is growing in, it is black, but the pigment production lessens as the hair gets longer, so the single hair has a black tis that fades to gray the farther down the hair shaft you go.

That's why the Pumi standard on color says (underlining is mine):

"...an intermixture of some gray, black or white hairs is acceptable <u>as long as the overall appearance of a solid color is maintained."</u>

"Disqualification - Any multiple-color pattern or patches, e.g., black and tan pattern, piebald, particulored."

An other aspect of this graying gene is that if the skin is damaged, or the hair is pulled out, the new hairs in that area will come in black and as they grow out will fade back to gray and blend in with the other hair. In both the above-mentioned cases this was the situation. You can see this in the photos





My advice if this occurs, is to stop showing your Pumi until the hair has grown in further and you can trim off the black tips. Adding a bit of grooming chalk to the black might help lighten it. But you could risk getting disqualified if a judge feels this is not "the overall appearance of a solid color".



## The Pedigree Corner – Adding Dogs in a Litter

The pedigree database now has 14,226 Pumik in it! In the last newsletter I mentioned that we were missing a lot of Hungarian dog, but in this issue I want to mention that we are missing a lot of American dogs! It is up to the breeders in the US to put the puppies they've produced into this database so we have a record of the Pumik produced by American breeders. If a breeder registers the puppies on behalf of the owners, this is simple. If a breeder allows the new puppy owners to individually register their puppy, it's been shown that the majority of pet owners never do register their puppy with the AKC and we have no idea of that puppy's existence.


The only way dogs get into this database is from someone entering each dog by hand. It is the breeder's responsibility to assure that their puppies are in this database. BUT, there is an easy way to add all the puppies in a litter at once.

#### Adding a Litter

This is similar to the "Litter ad" we discussed in the last issue. Click on add a dog on the dropdown menu (see below), and then click add a litter.



This will bring up a popup window:




Key in the mother's name (the system will give you the choice) and the father. Put in the date of birth, then click *Continue*. The screen changes to:



The name of the owner of the dam is automatically added as the breeder of record.

The following is added to the bottom of the screen.



Please note the instructions above. We recently had a upgrade to the pedigree application, and some of these instructions are new.

- Children with the same mother, father and DOB have been added automatically. You can add new animals or search for existing animals in the name field.
- All new and existing children in this list will get the mother, father, date of birth and breeder from the fields above.
- Removing animals from this list will not delete existing animals or remove them from this litter, but they will not be updated with possible changes.

These all explain how the adding a litter function works. If there are already puppies from this litter in the database, they will be added automatically when this screen shows up. The ones already in the database and added automatically cannot be changed except that the breeder will be added automatically along with the other fields that you can update.

The next one talks about a great function of the this screen:

- Entries in the grey line are applied to all animals on the list.

So for example, if you put "United States" in the gray line above on the County of Origin field, that will populate that field for all of the puppies. Same applies to color, so you can easily mark all puppies as "black".

The default screen shows 3 puppies (in addition to any added automatically), but you can add more lines by clicking the **+** add animal button.

Most of the fields available for individual dogs are available here by scrolling to the right, including all the health information, and color DNA information, microchip info, etc.

Clicking the **Submit** button will add each dog in the litter individually to the database! Done!
