Entry Fee

\$25.00 per entry per dog per test Closing date is May 31st, 2024 at noon EST (Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)
Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted.
Late Entries after May 31st, 2024 will be charged the day of show entry fee of \$30 per entry. Day of entries as space allows with secretary permission.

ABOUT RETURNED CHECKS: The trial secretary will not return checks for entries that are not accepted or entries cancelled by the competitor before the closing date and before the check has been deposited. All unused checks will be shredded. All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry. A Returned Check for insufficient funds will be charged an additional \$25 fee.

A running order will be emailed three days prior to the start of the trial, on Wednesday, June 5th, 2024. This schedule may be modified to account for day of show entries.Pre-entries will not have their scheduled times changed.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are registered with the AKC, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration and dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program on the day of the trial. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

If your mix breed dog needs an AKC Canine Partner number a form and information is available on page 5 in this Premium. It is only \$19.

Dogs may only run once per test. All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry.

Check in & Inspection.

You may check in for inspection 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the trial, or throughout the event. Every dog must pass through inspection before each run. Dogs who miss roll call will be skipped. If you do not check in within one hour prior to the end of the trial closing, we will assume you are absent. No refunds for absent dogs. At inspection, all dogs will be examined for disqualifications. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the

test. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded.

<u>Hours</u>

Grounds will be available one hour prior to trial hours. HPCA will do its best to accommodate exhibitors with conflicts in other venues, if any. However, exhibitors must notify the Trial Secretary of conflicts and work their dog into the running order during the schedule. It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready with catcher and releaser when their dog is called to the line.

<u>Prizes</u>

A flat blue ribbon for a passing qualifying run. Rosettes to dogs completing title, as available. Please notify the Trial Secretary in advance if you anticipate completing a title. Please note on the bottom of the entry form.

*The following prizes will be awarded by the Hungarian Pumi Club of America: Top Pumi Dog & Bitch each day wins a glitter dog bowl with HPCA logo.

What is the Fast CAT?

1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.

2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.

3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

4. Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

5. FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

6. Titles are earned at specific point levels.

BCAT = 150 points, DCAT = 500 points, FCAT = 1,000 points


FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

*ACCORDING TO AKC RULES; Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name only. **Collar Rules**: Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, electronic training collars or head collar. Collars should be snug. Hanging tags pose a safety concern and it is suggested that tags be secured to the collar with tape. Dogs may run muzzled if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from falling across the dog's field of vision.

Trial Site Directions

From I-95: Exit #16 East Norwalk go south on East Avenue for ½ mile. Turn left on Van Zant Street, and right on Gregory Boulevard for ½ mile. Turn left on Marvin Street and immediate right on Calf Pasture Beach Boulevard ½ mile to the show site. Use the dog show EXHIBITOR entrance, take a left and travel past all the tenting to back parking lot. \$5 per day parking fee.

From Merritt Parkway and US-7: Exit #39 south on US-7 to I-95 north for one exit to Exit #16 and proceed as above.

HPCA Trial Information

Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

• ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK.

• All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.

• This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs, and water.

• An electric and electronic timing system will be used.

• The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced.

- On site bathrooms are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.

• A fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.

• You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.

• Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.

• The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/She has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.

• Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/HPCA/GKC/ dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded**.

• No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

Daily Parking


